- Visualize my data by creating one or more charts based on defined data and criteria?
- Create custom formula fields using SQL functions and incorporate them into criteria, pivot tables and charts?
- Publish workbook pivot tables and charts to user dashboards using the Analytics portlet?

To get the most out of this course, you should be able to navigate the NetSuite user interface and complete general administrative tasks. Familiarity with creating ad-hoc queries and reports using standard NetSuite searches and reports is beneficial, but not required.

Pivot Tables: In this module, we will discuss pivot tables and how they can be used to aggregate and summarize your workbook source data.

Publishing Workbooks: In this module, we will examine some of the ways workbook data can be published to other users in NetSuite.
